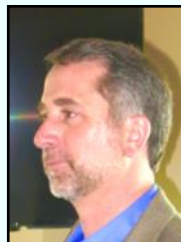

PRESIDENTS MESSAGE



Well we are well into winter now with our cars all safely tucked away. However, spring driving in New England is only a month or so away. Some lucky members are breaking up this 356-driving hiatus with a trip to Los Angeles to attend the 35th Annual Porsche and Vin-



tage VW Literature, Toy and Memorabilia Meet held at LAX Hilton Hotel on Saturday, March 3, 2018. This year there is an extra good reason to go to LA and that is to visit the Petersen Automotive Museum. From February 2018 until January 2019 the Petersen is hosting a large Porsche Exhibit entitled: The Porsche Effect. This exhibit details the history of the Porsche brand development in five thematic sections: Elements of Style; Zuffenhausen and Beyond; Extended Families; Innovation through Competition; and Word/Image/Object. The only place you will likely find more Porsches on display with more information about them would be to travel to the Porsche Museum in Stuttgart. So, if you cannot make it to LA for the Lit Meet try to get there before January of next year to see this exhibit.

Also, while you are there, be sure to take a tour of the Porsche Experience Center in Los Angeles. The Experience Center is a 53-acre facility that really allows you to experience the Porsche brand. There is a 4-mile Driver Development Track where you can sign up to drive, with a Porsche Driving Coach in the Porsche model of your choice, to get a one-on-one experience of what driving these cars as they were meant to be driven is like. They also have driving simulators, for your use, where you can experience virtual driving on the world's top tracks. They have fine dining on site at Restaurant 917 with a Speedster Café bar and patio.

If you do go to LA for the Lit Meet this year or next, be sure to also go to the annual 356 Club hosted So. Cal All-Porsche Swap and Car Display at the Phoenix Club in Anaheim, CA starting at 8 AM, Sunday, March 4, 2018. This is a huge swap meet with many good deals to be had with lots of club members' cars on display.

Be sure to attend our next TYP356ne Club event on Saturday, March 24th; a guided tour by Club member, Alex Finigan, of one of the world's outstanding classic car restoration shops, Paul Russell and Company in Essex, MA. (see page 8). This event will be limited to 50 club members and guests; so be sure to sign up early. Alex tells me that he would like it if members could bring an interested teenager as a guest since they would like to foster an interest in classic cars in the next generation. The loss of a legend. Dan Gurney passed away on January 15th at the age of 86.

Dan Gurney was an extremely talented driver, constructor and race team manager. His ties to Porsche go way back. Dan began racing a TR2 in 1955, but his first victory was driving his 1956 Speedster. During his Formula One career he drove for Ferrari, BRM, Porsche and Brabham. In 1961 and '62, he raced for Porsche's Formula 1 team and achieved a pole at the Nurburgring and Porsche's lone F1 victory in the 1962 French Grand Prix.

Dan Gurney, as well as being a world-class driver who survived and excelled in one of racing's most deadly eras, was one of motorsport's greatest innovators and free-thinking spirits. He, eventually, formed his own team and won the Belgian Grand Prix in 1967 in his own car; the only time an American won an F1 race in a car of their own design. His

Gurney/Westlake Eagle was not only fast but one of the most beautiful race cars ever built. I had the pleasure to see the one below at the Glen many years ago. Ed. T

This edition of Tub Times will officially open registration for our tour of Paul Russell Restorations at 106 Western Avenue, Essex, MA. 01929

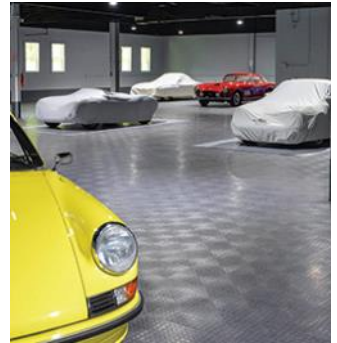

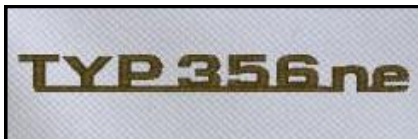

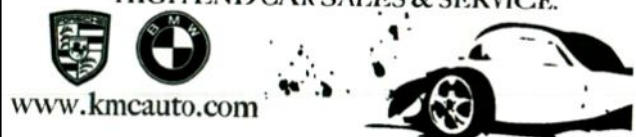
