



The real reason why Porsche ignition keys are on the left side of the steering wheel.

In the March 29th issue of the Wall Street Journal there was an article by Dan Neil, about Porsche's unique location of the key on the left (outboard) side of the steering wheel. The article says some dealers have told buyers that it was positioned there for racing at Le Mans, however, he says that is not true. It goes on to say that it is really located on the left to save wire, which was in short supply at the factory back then. Sounds plausible, however, being left handed, I like to think that Dr. Porsche was also left handed (?) and he did it for us southpaws !!!


Anaheim Swap Meet
